





As a teacher, Monique enjoys developing unique pedagogical materials for the modern vocalist. Some of these programs include improvisation, the art of backing vocals, riffs and runs and more. In January of this year, she put out her first e-course: "The Ultimate Vocal Riffs Guide"!

Monique loves to travel and spends a great deal of her time on the road teaching masterclasses, directing choirs and performing as a lead and backing vocalist for many well known artists. ### Francesco Mecorio Hong Kong

FRANCESCO MECORIO is a very active vocal coach and singing teacher with an international career. He has been teaching sung and spoken voice for more than 20 years now. He trained in pop / rock, jazz, soul, gospel, opera and musical theater by attending courses, lectures, workshops, lectures and seminars in singing, spoken voice, medicine applied to the artistic voice and vocal pedagogy in Italy and abroad (United Kingdom, United States, Australia).

He has earned the EMT (Estill Master Trainer, formerly CMT) certification under the guidance of Elisa Turlà in 2012, and the EMCI (Estill Mentor and Course Instructor, formerly CCI) certification in 2020 under the mentorship of Anne-Marie Speed, with whom perfected in London since 2011. He attended the Estill World Voice Symposia in Rome (2011), Boston at Harvard University (2013), Melbourne (2015) and London (2019) and the 10th Estill World Voice Symposium online (2021). He has lived in Korea from 2013 to 2019 working as a researcher and university professor at the Musical Theater department of Hongik University in Seoul, one of the most renowned Asian universities in the field of art, where he held the professorships of Vocal Training 1, Musical Vocal Training 1, 2 and 3, and the Music Repertoire and Performance courses (Performing Arts Lab) in the Graduate School of Performing Arts. In 2022 he was a lecturer at HKAPA -Hong Kong Academy for performing Arts, ranked 1st university in Asia and 10th in the world for Performing Arts. (QS World University Ranking). In Italy he has been teaching privately since 2000 and has taught in various schools and academies of music and entertainment. He was vocal coach among others of Silvia Caracristi ("The Voice of Italy", winner of "Sanremolab 2007"), Deborah Calì ("Moldova are talent") and of many TV soloists and choristers and musical theater performers. Francesco's research studies have been presented in national and international conferences in Korea, Italy and Poland. He is a member of the editorial board of the ePhonoscope magazine and reviewer of the "Journal of Hearing Science"

### **WORKSHOP**

#### BELTING

BELTING is a specific type of high-intensity vocal production used in musical theatre, CCM, several types of folk music, and in some cases even in acting and some opera performances. Exciting and thrilling, often loosely, mistakenly or summarily called a "high-range chest voice" or "mix," its common definition, as well as its relationship to vocal health, can be controversial. The number of artists that use belting in their performances increases every day, especially in countries where its definition was unknown until a few years ago. More and more teachers started teaching it or mentioning it in their lessons. However, dealing with belting without exact knowledge of its mechanics and specific and precise training can be very frustrating and dangerous.

A detailed physiological description of belting and a series of targeted and sophisticated exercises are the basis for effective and sustainable belting production. There are "do's and don'ts" for establishing healthy and successful belting.

In this workshop, all the physiological and acoustic characteristics of belting will be explored and practical training will be presented to set up belting safely. A basic practice will be presented and practised individually on each exercise by every partecipants, and an advanced practice (belting carried high, use or removal of vibrato, different styles of belting, problems and solutions, belting and phonetics) will be presented in groups and proposed as individual work only if circumstances allow it.





### Claire McCartin Malta

Claire is a well-known vocalist with a distinctive blues voice and over the years, has held performances in various countries, namely the USA, Russia and Austria. From 2000-2016, Claire was a member and soloist of the famous 200-strong Maltese choir Voices and was also a 2010 Malta Eurovision finalist. She is the Maltese agent for the UK examination board Rockschool and in 2022, was part of the vocal coaching team on the first-ever edition of The Voice Kids Malta. She is also the resident vocal coach of the production company Arthaus MT, with whom she worked on various musical theatre productions since 2009, such as The Addams Family and Chicago.

In 2007, Claire joined the critically acclaimed Speech Level Singing (SLS) organisation and worked as a certified SLS instructor for five years. She completed a two-year course with the renowned Berklee College of Music, Boston, USA and currently forms part of the Institute for Vocal Advancement (IVA), Modern Vocal Training (MVT), and also Profty, the creator of the world's best artist development programs. She is also certified as a Manual Laryngeal Therapist.

She works from her personal vocal studio mentoring several established and upcoming artists, and since October 2022, she has also been working with a music publishing company in Rome, Italy. Her students include the winners of the Maltese Konkors Kanzunetta Indipendenza festival in 2018 and 2021, the winner of the Maltese Ghanja tal-Poplu festival in 2019, the San Marino representative at the Eurovision Song Contest in Portugal 2018, and the Maltese representative at the Junior Eurovision Song Contest in Poland 2020.

### Dott. Francesco Palmirotta Italy

Dr. Francesco Palmirotta is a psychologist, psychotherapist and philosopher. In 1960 he began his musical studies and continued them later as a self-taught musician, opening up to the knowledge of various instruments (wind, percussion, electronic) and various musical styles and genres, all revisited in a personal way. During the years of his university studies, he came into contact with music therapy experiences of various genres. Later he devoted himself to the study of ethnic music, among others the so-called pizzica pizzica, typical of Southern Italy.

From reflection on these experiences, a music therapy intervention modality was born, which merges the Magna-Greek conceptions of harmony (Pythagoras), with the psychosomatic approach of psychotherapeutic maieutics, to arrive at Psychosomatic Music Therapy. Francesco Palmirotta has done hundreds of collaborations, directed research in the field of Ontosophy and Music Therapy, and is a speaker at conferences at national and international levels.

Just to mention a few of his professional experiences:

### **WORKSHOP**

### **ONTOSOPHY IN MUSIC THERAPY**

The seminar will be held at different stages three or four parts and everyone can participate regardless of their artistic background.

The wisdom of being, ontosophy, since the beginnings of Pythagorean choreautics has has hoisted Italian bel canto through Gregorian chant and all the modulations of Italian opera. In this seminar we would like to reintroduce it as the novella Snow White neglected or misunderstood but ever present with its whiteness of principle to enlighten and nurture virtuous consciences that wish to sing the soul from the wisdom of human beings in harmony with the frequency of the earth dancing around the sun in the rhythm of a night and day that lasts 24 hours.

What the participants of the ontosophy workshop take home is the crisp and clear psychosomatic consciousness that our voice is the result of the wisdom of our human being that if it sings for harmony or in harmony with the living intentionality of the planet earth (the 432 Herz) it makes harmony that is psychosomatic wellness. And this was with known from the Pythagorean school that founded with Pythagoras and Aristoxenus from Taranto the music, music therapy and choreutics that is foundation of Italian bel canto.





### Iskra Milkova Bulgaria

Iskra Milkova has been immersed in the world of music since early childhood. Graduating Art high school with a concentration in piano, she soon discovered that her true passion lay within the power of the human voice, with its unique ability to move people's hearts.

This passion led her to the National Academy of Music "Pancho Vladigerov", where she earned her master's degree in pop and jazz singing.

Driven by her desire to grow and explore modern teaching methods, she pursued further education at the Institute for Vocal Advancement (IVA) in the USA and Modern Vocal Training (MVT) in Spain, where she deeply immersed herself in the Speech Level Singing (SLS) teaching method.

Inspired by newfound knowledge and vocal approaches, Iskra established HighLight Singing Academy. Today, the academy is home to a team of 20 exceptional teachers who cultivate a share their passion for voice, singing, and teaching. In 2014, Iskra was invited to become a vocal coach of the popular TV SHOW "X Factor of Bulgaria". Here, she collaborated with some of the country's finest producers and artists over four exciting seasons. This experience not only expanded her professional network but also sharpened her vision of the qualities singers must develop to thrive in the competitive music industry.

In parallel to her role as a vocal pedagogue, Iskra continues to feed her soul as an active performer with various bands and engages in diverse musical projects.

One of Iskra's most recent success story as a vocal coach is: her student Jaklin Tarakchi, won The Voice of Bulgaria 2022.

### **WORKSHOP**

#### **HOW TO PREPARE FOR TV TALENT SHOWS**

In this workshop "How to Prepare for TV shows" we will learn how to overcome different challenges and practically we will go through all the key stages and crucial moments. The program will include:

### PERFORMANCE TECHNIQUE FOR LIVE CONCERT

### PERFORMANCE TECHNIQUE FOR VIDEO

The workshop is a practical study in order to acquire more technical and interpretive skills.

Starting with a brief analysis of the ideal interpretive training path for the singer, we will move on to the analysis of individual difficulties related to the performance aspect. Each participant will be invited to bring a couple of songs to interpret so that the study of their interpretive skills will be practical and tangible.

Starting from the analysis of the difficulties and unexplored expressive potential of each of the individual participants, suitable suggestions and solutions will be sought to enhance the performance of a song. It will also be the teacher's responsibility to go and address and analyze the difference in interpretive language depending on whether one has to perform in front of a video camera or on a stage.

### **WORKSHOP**

#### SINGING IMPROVISATION

Improvisation is a fascinating aspect of being a singer and musician. It has far origins and is found in different musical languages; in jazz music it has found a warm home, giving us continuous insights for growth and research. Following the basic elements of musical speech, we will take a musical journey discovering the potential of the instrument voice and its free expression through improvisation.

In the first part of our workshop, we will explore rhythm and melody with the use of syllable scat (conventional - scat conventional), call & response formulas, scales, arpeggios, chords, discovering the relationship between rule and freedom and developing listening and communication among all participants.

In the second part, melodies from the pop, jazz and gospel repertoire will be the perfect springboard for our improvisational and interpretive experiences.

Everyone with their own sonic background and musical sensibility will contribute to create the Voice of Improvisation and the Joy of Singing.

#### HOW TO PERFORM AT A JAM SESSION

A jam session is an occasion where musicians come together to collectively play and improvise music. It's an inclusive stage where both newcomers and seasoned veterans alike take their turns, fostering a spirit of enjoyment, musical exploration, and social interaction. The workshop will empower you with the skills and knowledge needed to confidently take part as a vocalist in a jam session, guiding you through the following essential steps:

- 1. Song Selection: choosing appropriate songs
- 2. Interplaying: The singer's role in collaboration with the musicians.
- 3. Song Structure: timing, intro, theme, solos, ending.

Upon completion of this workshop, you will revel in the delight of singing alongside live musicians, unlocking a newfound joy in musical collaboration


